



Now that summer is here, please take a few minutes to review some pertinent Borough ordinances:

Consumer **fireworks** (as defined by PA law) or sparkling devices are NEVER permitted to be used, ignited, or discharged in the borough. Violators will be fined.

Residents and/or contractors are not allowed to blow/sweep **grass clippings** into the street. This will avoid clogging storm drains and/or the creek water system.

No person shall **burn** anything within the limits of the streets or highways of the borough. The outdoor burning of tree branches, leaves, shrubs, construction materials and any other debris or waste is prohibited within the borough.

It is the responsibility of the homeowner (or tenant) to ensure that their **exterior property** is:

- maintained free from weeds or grass more than six inches. It is also the homeowner’s responsibility to remove grass/weeds on the homeowner’s sidewalk as well as between the curb and street.
- free from any accumulation of abandoned, discarded, or unused objects to stay in a clean, safe, and sanitary condition.
