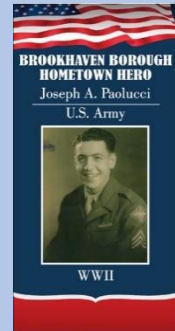


Preserve the Memory of Your Hometown Hero
