In the early 1950's as developers looked to start construction of multiple new homes in Brookhaven there were still some who took the initiative to *go it alone*. Charles Wojciehowski, a machinist, and his father Anthony took ten months to build a single-story six-room brick home on the corner of Middletown and Brookhaven Roads. - In the September 2025 Newsletter we provided information on the [BusPatrol Safety Program](#) that Penn Delco School District launched at the start of the new school year. As of February 1st, there have been 114 violations throughout the Borough. A civil fine of \$300 is issued to persons confirmed of passing a stopped school bus. On the bright side, we've not seen any repeat violators so hopefully getting the fine is causing drivers to be more cautious around stopped school buses. You may want to take a few minutes to review the "[rules of the road](#)" surrounding a school bus stopping.

...that the Brookhaven Borough Fire Code is a law that establishes fire safety requirements for buildings and businesses in Brookhaven Borough. Brookhaven's latest major codes are from the [2024 International Fire Code \(IFC\)](#) by the International Code Council (ICC) and the 2024 National Fire Protection Association ([NFPA 1, Fire Code](#)). These 2024 editions provide the most current minimum regulations for fire prevention, life safety, and hazards.
