- **Too many adult mosquitos!!** Due to high trap counts and West Nile Virus detections, the Delaware County Health Department's (DCHD) Mosquito-Borne Disease Control Program will conduct an Ultra-Low Volume (ULV) mosquito adulticide spray on Tuesday, 9/2/25, approx. 7:30-10:30pm. - The Fire Marshal offers [Back to School Safety Tips](#): to help ensure children travel safely to and from school, hints for parents to exercise caution on social media, and reminds everyone to **SLOW DOWN THROUGH SCHOOL ZONES**.
- The Brookhaven Town Watch will be holding its 9/11 Memorial Service on Wednesday, September 11th at 6:30pm at the Brookhaven Municipal Center. Please come out for this service in remembrance of the impact of September 11th.
- Penn Delco School District has launched the [BusPatrol Safety Program](#). This initiative equips all school buses with cameras that will identify vehicles that fail to stop for the school buses. Video evidence will be forwarded to the local police department who will issue a violation -- \$300 for first-time violation.
- The Brookhaven Municipal Center Gym will be closed from Monday, 8/25 to Monday, 9/15 for floor maintenance, including sanding and urethane coating.
- Parking in a fire zone is illegal and subject to fines and/or towing. The Fire Marshal and Police Department have noticed an uptick in the number of vehicles parking in fire lanes in the borough particularly at the Brookhaven Shopping Center. It is important to remember that the purpose of a fire zone, also known as a fire lane, is to give emergency vehicles unobstructed access to a building or fire hydrant, which can be critical for saving lives and property. **Do not be surprised if there is an uptick in the number of tickets issued!**

Ordinance Insight

Did You Know? Brookhaven Now Regulates Smoke Shop Locations! To promote public health and a safer community, Brookhaven Borough has enacted **Ordinance No. 849** (effective June 2, 2025), updating zoning rules for smoke shops.

What is a "Smoke Shop" -- any retail or wholesale establishment that sells—or is marketed as selling—tobacco, vaping products, or accessories (and includes stores where at least 20% of inventory falls into these categories).

- **No smoke shop** may open within **1,000 feet of another smoke shop.**
- **No smoke shop** may be located within **1,000 feet of any school.**

These changes help limit the concentration of such businesses and protect our neighborhoods, especially our youth. [CLICK HERE](#) to explore the full text of the ordinance.



Reminder: Starting **September 2**, Brookhaven Borough's **quiet hours will be from 9:00pm to 7:00am**, in accordance with the **amended Noise Control Ordinance No. 847** (adopted on May 5, 2025). *Note that from Memorial Day through Labor Day the quiet hours are from 10:00pm to 7:00am.*
