**AN ORDINANCE OF THE BOROUGH OF BROOKHAVEN, COUNTY
OF DELAWARE, COMMONWEALTH OF PENNSYLVANIA, FIXING
THE ANNUAL SEWER RENTAL CHARGE FOR THE YEAR 2026
AND PROVIDING FOR THE COLLECTION OF THE SAME**

BE IT ENACTED AND ORDAINED, and it is hereby enacted and ordained, by the Council of the Borough of Brookhaven, County of Delaware, Commonwealth of Pennsylvania:

Section 1. The annual sewer rental charge for each unit for the calendar year 2026 shall be as follows: Zone 1 = \$516.36; Zone 2 = \$516.36; Zone 3 = \$516.36; Zone 4 = \$763.69; Zone 5 = \$514.36.

Section 2. All sewer rental charges due pursuant to this Ordinance shall be due and payable by the owner of the unit on or before May 31, 2026. In the event payment is not received by May 31, 2026, a penalty of ten percent (10%) shall be added to the bill. Interest at the rate of nine percent (9%) per annum will be imposed on all sewer rental charges paid after December 31st of the current year. All delinquent sewer rental charges due under this Ordinance shall be collected by filing a municipal lien against the property as provided by law.

Section 3. A fee of two hundred fifty (\$250.00) dollars shall be added as an attorney fee for the filing of any municipal lien which sum shall be added to the amount of the delinquency, including interest, penalty and costs.

Section 4. Attorney fees are hereby assessed at the rate of one hundred eight-five (\$185.00) dollars per hour for the collection of delinquent municipal claims which necessitate legal proceedings.

Section 5. The fee established under this Ordinance shall be collected by the Borough Tax Collector, whose compensation for the collection of such fee shall be set by Borough Council.

Section 6. All Ordinance or parts thereof inconsistent herewith are repealed, rescinded, cancelled and annulled.
