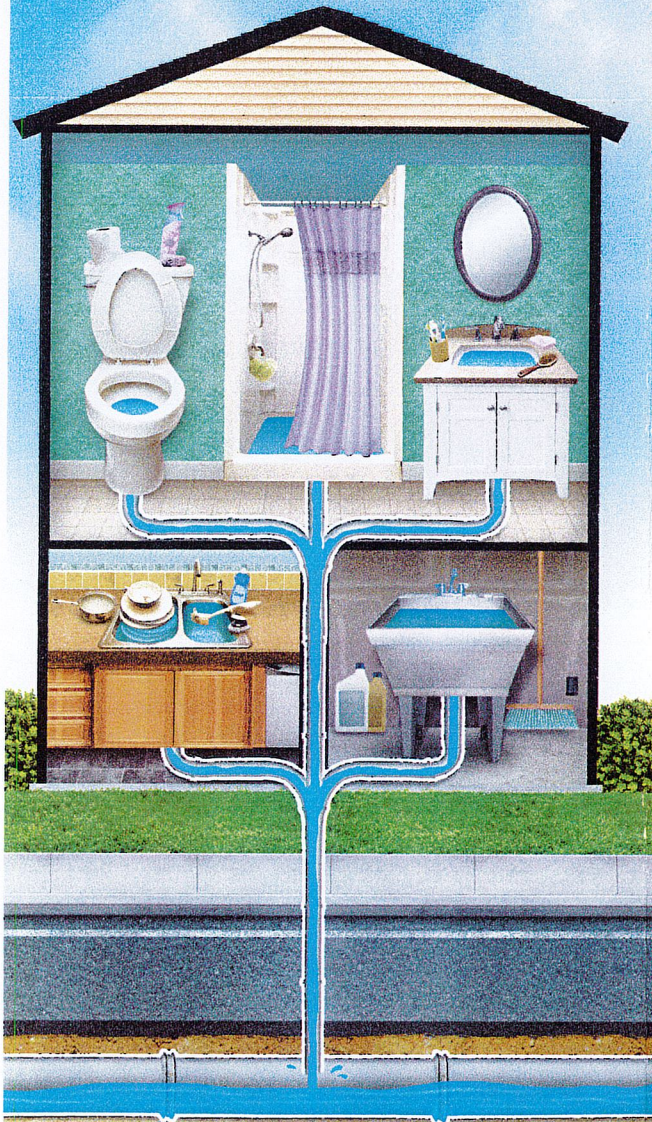


## All drains in your home flow into the same sewer pipe!



Clogged pipes can cause expensive and messy sewer backups and overflows in your home and in our City. If you notice a serious problem in or near your home, or on a street, call DELCORA Customer Service at 610-876-5526.

Fats, oils, and grease (F.O.G.) from food waste, scraps and cooking when poured down the drain, clog pipes and cause sewer backups and overflows.

### THESE SIMPLE TIPS CAN HELP YOU STAY CLOG-FREE:

- NEVER pour grease or cooking oil down drains or garbage disposals.
- For small amounts of F.O.G., scrape out or use paper towels to wipe your pans, and then place the F.O.G. or soiled paper towels in your trash.
- For large amounts of F.O.G., such as used oil from a turkey fryer, collect cooled oil in a sealable container and dispose of properly.
- Use food strainers in kitchen sinks to catch food particles and place them into the garbage or compost.



Not managed properly, F.O.G. can solidify and stick to the sides of your kitchen drains and sewer pipes.

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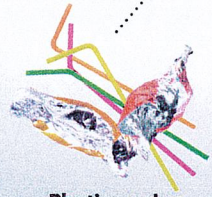

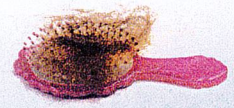
Dental Floss
